Inappropriate Games and Movies

In school, we have been concerned recently by the number of children who are talking to us (and writing) about films that they have watched and interactive games that they are playing at home which are **not suitable for children**. Children have spoken to us about watching *The Purge* (rated 15), *Deadpool* (rated 15) and playing *Grand Theft Auto* (rated 18) amongst others. These films are rated at the ages that they are for good reason. It is your responsibility as parents to ensure that your children are not exposed to inappropriate language, violence or other behaviours. If you do not fulfil this responsibility then this can be classed as a form of abuse. If school is aware of children being regularly exposed to inappropriate films/games then we have a duty to report this to Lincolnshire Children's Services. Please ensure that you are protecting your child from seeing inappropriate action, which it is proven that they may try to imitate, by monitoring/controlling carefully what they are watching/playing. Thank you.
