### Bikeability—Herons Class

This week, Monday—Thursday, several of Herons class were busy doing their Bikeability training making them safer cyclists. The weather was not very kind to them but they all carried on regardless through strong wind and rain. The children started their training on the playground learning basic cycling skills before going out on to the roads around the village. They have all learned to do important manoeuvres on the road safely, including a U turn, turning left into a junction and turning right out of a junction. The children had to concentrate really hard and listen carefully to instructions.

Thank you to the parents of these children for encouraging them to take part—it has helped them to understand the importance of riding safely on the roads and we hope that lots more children will take part when they are old enough in years to come.

### Speed Limits

Unfortunately there are ongoing concerns about the speed that some cars travel through the village and outside school. Please make sure that your child is kept safe by keeping them with you when arriving at and leaving school. If there continues to be an issue with this then the school will contact the police to ask for their help in keeping our children safe. The children in school are all being given lessons in PSHE on how to keep themselves safe on the roads.

**Bug Club** At the end of last year all children were given a book mark with log in details for the interactive reading resource that we use in school. There are lots of books on there for the children to read and they can earn points for their comprehension of what they have read to add things to their world. The children will be using this in school for some reading sessions. If your child reads from the Bug Club website at home this can be counted as one of their reads—just enter it into their reading record and it will be counted towards the cinema and reading certificate.
