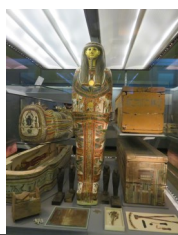
Shared Curriculum Morning

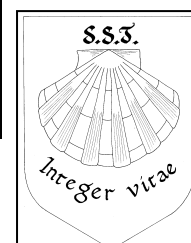


JRSO Assembly
