

SATs

Next week is a very important week for our Year 6 pupils who will be sitting their SAT tests. These are very important tests for the children as they are compulsory and all children in England have to sit the tests on the same day. These tests are then sent away to be marked and children are informed of their outcomes in July. The results are recorded on the children's school records and are used to predict their GCSE results. Pupils in Year 2 will also be sitting their SATs. These tests are statutory and are used to reinforce teacher judgements. These tests are marked in school by the class teacher.

We would like to wish all of our pupils Good Luck in their tests and to remind them that these tests only measure their literacy and numeracy ability, not their strength of character, their skills and talents in all other subjects and their ability to be kind, caring and compassionate human beings.

We encourage them all to try their best and want them to know that we are very proud of them!
