Well Done Year 6

Water Bottles

It has been noticed that an increasing number of children do not have a water bottle in school with them in the classroom to have a drink from during lessons. Soon the water fountains around school will be taken away and replaced with filtered water coolers. There will not be any cups available for the children to use with the water coolers so it will be even more important that the children have a water bottle in school. Children will be allowed to refill their water bottles at break or lunchtime. This is even more important during the warmer weather, especially when we complete our Fit and Fun 15 minutes during the afternoon. The children should drink lots of water throughout the day to help them to remain hydrated and healthy. If you require a school water bottle these can be purchased from the school office for £1. Alternatively any other similar sized clear bottle (e.g. an empty supermarket bought water bottle) can be sent in to school. Please ensure that your child has a bottle in school with them.



Sun Hats and Sunglasses



Please ensure that your child has a sunhat in school to wear during playtimes, Fit and Fun 15 and outdoor PE lessons in the summer months. Ideally this should be in school everyday because the weather can change and even though it may not be sunny when you drop your child off in the morning it may be brilliant sunshine by midday. Hats are available to buy from the office in 2 different styles (peak caps, one having a neck protector). Sunglasses are not encouraged in school for safety reasons and because if the children have got a sunhat on which protects their head their eyes will also be protected.



Sun-cream

In the sunny summer weather you may wish to apply sun-cream to your child in the mornings before they come to school. Ideally you could apply sun-cream that lasts for the full day. However if your child will need to reapply sun-cream at lunchtime it can be sent into school with them but they must apply it to themselves. It is also extremely important that the children **do not share** their sun-cream with their friends in case they are allergic to it.



Pirates Day Reminder

A quick reminder that on the first day back after half term we will be having our Pirates Theme Day. The children are encouraged to come in costume on this day to help them get into the spirit of things.
