Dear Parents,

On **Friday 11<sup>th</sup> November** we will be having our **Children In Need fundraising day**. We know that this is a week earlier than the television appeal but the following Friday is also Anti-Bullying Day and we wanted both days to have equal importance and hence have chosen to make it two separate days rather than trying to combine the two.

**Non- Uniform**

The children will be allowed to come to school in non-uniform, but as usual there will be a twist for this special day. This year we are all going to come to school wearing our clothes inside out and back to front (except for our shoes)! Everything must be inside out and back to front, including our socks and underwear! Children should bring in a **donation of £1** to give to charity, which will be collected in class at registration in the morning.

**Covering the Spots**

This year we have decided that our house competition for this term will be combined with Children In Need Day with the children being asked to **bring in pennies to cover coloured spots** on the floor in the hall. Dotted around the floor in the hall will be lots of spots of different sizes in the colours of the four houses. The children will go down to the hall with their classes and use their pennies to cover the spots which are their house colour. The money for each house will then be collected in and counted and the house raising the most money will win the house competition for the term.

**In the Spotlight**

We will be holding a **talent competition** on the morning of Friday 11<sup>th</sup> for all children in the school to enter. The children can choose to perform individual, in pairs, trios or as a group. Their talent could be anything; from singing, playing a musical instrument, performing magic tricks or dancing. On Thursday of next week auditions will be held in each class and the children will decide on the three best acts from their own class who will then go on to perform 'In The Spotlight' on Friday morning.
