

Literacy

This term we will be concentrating on the features of factual reading and writing. We will be reading non-fiction books and will ask the children to use these features in their own writing using formal language. We will look at reports, recounts and instructions and making an information book. Sentence work will continue using connectives and adjectives and introducing new vocabulary

Personal, Social and Emotional Development/PSHE

This term we will be supporting the children to develop their caring and sharing skills. We will be encouraging the children to understand that their actions may affect other people, how they can help and support others if they become upset but also how to consider and change their actions before someone becomes upset.

Mathematics

We will continue with our work on numbers to 20 and begin to look at each part of a two digit number. We will introduce the vocabulary related to time and begin to tell the time to o'clock. Shape and capacity work will be extended and sharing will be introduced through activities related to our stories.

Physical

In Gymnastics we will be exploring travelling; taking the weight on different parts of our bodies. We will expect the children to use a range of tools and materials effectively and safely. We will also be learning about how to transport and store a variety of equipment safely.

Religious Education

This term we will be discussing how books are special and how to care for them. We will be listening to and discussing stories about Jesus.

Communication and

Language/Literacy

We will be giving the children opportunities to extend and develop their language and vocabulary, using new words in their play, imagining and recreating stories and character roles. We will encourage the children to follow stories without props and will be working on developing the children's ability to listen and do at the same time.

Expressive Arts/ Art and DT

We will be using a variety of tools and media to design and create 3D vehicles. We will be extending our techniques and looking at alternative ways of joining and assembling models. The children will be extending their work on colour choosing and mixing and developing their work on printing. We will continue to work on developing narratives and storylines and encouraging the children to work as a group to act out their stories.

Understanding of the World/Geography & History

This term we will be learning about the Emergency Services - how and when we should contact them, who they are and what they do. We will investigate the materials they use for their uniforms and why these materials are chosen and the vehicles they use. The children will learn about related events and people from the past such as Florence Nightingale and The Great Fire of London.
