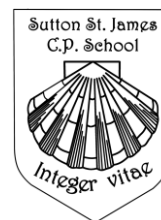

Suspected case of Hand, Foot and Mouth Disease

Dear Parents

We have been informed of 1 suspected case of Hand, Foot and Mouth Disease in Wrens class yesterday. This has not yet been confirmed to us.

Hand, foot, and mouth disease (HFMD) is a common infection caused by a group of viruses. It typically begins with a fever and feeling generally unwell. This is followed a day or two later by flat discoloured spots or bumps that may blister, on the hands, feet and mouth. Signs and symptoms normally appear 3–6 days after exposure to the virus. The rash generally goes away on its own in about a week.

Please check your child and if you notice any spots in these areas , consult the doctors and follow their advice.
