

### History:

Children will learn who the ancient Maya civilization were. They will discover their number and writing systems. Children will find out about explorers who discovered ancient cities. They will also consider the significance of corn and chocolate.

### Maths:

The children will continue to develop their knowledge and understanding of arithmetic and reasoning.

### English:

Children will continue to develop their grammar, punctuation and spelling skills through writing activities in a range of genres.

### Geography:

The children will develop their understanding of key features of maps.

The children will compare parts of America looking at the climate, landscape and locations.

### PSHE/SEAL:

Healthy Lifestyle – Children will learn about healthy foods, the importance of keeping fit and stress relief.

Relationships. – Children will learn about healthy relationships.

### Art/DT:

The children will look at Maya art work and create their own versions.

Children will look at buildings from the time to design their own.

### Science:

Forces – the children will find out about balanced and unbalanced forces, friction and the use of mechanisms such as levers, pulleys and gears.

Living things and habitats – the children will learn about the classification of living things, including micro-organisms.

### RE:

Christianity – children will learn about the key beliefs held by Christians including the Holy Trinity and life after death (Heaven).
