

Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 6 Homework.

As you will be aware, Y6 SATS week is fast approaching (9-12 May). With this in mind, I have made changes to homework for this year group. These changes will begin this week and will continue until the children have sat their tests.

The children will be given four tasks for their homework each week: a grammar task; a maths task; a reading task and a writing task.

The grammar, reading and maths tasks will be in a test format. The children should give themselves 10 minutes for each test. Once the 10 minutes has been reached they should indicate where they have got to and can then finish the questions at their own pace.

Each week children will be given a writing task. They will also have Success Criteria and need to ensure that this is met,

Please do not help the children with any of these homework tasks as I want these pieces of work to help me to inform my overall judgement of the children, allowing me to ascertain where there are gaps in their knowledge as well as what they are good at. The tasks are also designed to help them build up speed and accuracy.

These changes only affect Year 6 children, all other year groups' homework remains in the same format. I have been through the changes with the children so they are aware of the requirements.

As is usual, homework will be given out on a Friday and must be handed in on the following Wednesday.
