Science

This term we will be learning all about plants! We will be carrying out lots of practical experiments to find out how what plants need to grow and what they are made of. We will also be looking at the water cycle and thinking about how this then helps plants to grow.

Art/DT

Our science topic fits perfectly with DT to help us learn about the food that we can grow ourselves. We will even get the chance to design and make our own meals using natural ingredients! Whilst learning about our local area, we will be recording what we see using our very own sketch books. We will learn how to use lots of exciting techniques, including creating different tones and using a variety of brush strokes.

ICT

This term, we will be learning to design our own simple games to develop our programming skills. We will also be using technology throughout other subjects to develop our typing skills and our ability to use a computer safely and effectively.

PSHE/SEAL

We will continue to have a weekly PSHE session that will cover a variety of topics including our own emotions; the importance of exercise and hygiene. Our main topic will be 'Developing a safer and healthier lifestyle'.

Music

We are lucky enough to continue to have our music lessons with Miss Harris, including learning to *write* music using the correct music notes, as well as getting to try a range of instruments.

French

We will be building up our confidence by having simple conversations in French and learning more vocabulary about the weather and colours.

PE

This term, Owls will continue to have weekly PE lessons, including a games session each Friday to practice our teamwork skills. We are also going to have a go at orienteering to learn more about our surroundings.

History

We will be doing a local study of Sutton Saint James this term learning about the key aspects of the village. This will include the history of some of the buildings as well as the development of agriculture in the area. We will also learn what makes the Fens a special place.

RE

Throughout the summer term, our topic for RE is 'Religion in the Neighbourhood'. We will be considering our own beliefs and comparing them to those around us in our local community. We will focus on a range of religions and their beliefs, including Christianity, Hinduism, Buddhism and Judaism.

Maths

This term we will be advancing our skills in maths by applying what we know to problems. We will be able to solve problems that relate to real life, for example, by using money. We will continue to progress through Times Table Rockstars and we will be learning to divide using different methods. Maths units that we will cover include place value; shape and measurement; statistics and fractions.

Geography

Our topic is perfect for learning how to create maps and use equipment such as a compass. We will be using our local environment to do some real fieldwork, as well as exploring our local surroundings to think about the importance of agriculture where we live.
