Science

We will be learning about plants. The children will find out what plants need to survive. We will also look at the water cycle.

Art/DT

This term we will be focusing on landscape artists. The children will use a range of techniques to create an image of our local area.

Literacy

The children will be looking at a variety of different aspects in Literacy this term in keeping with our theme:

- We will be focusing on the features of Non-Fiction texts.
- Gaining the skills needed to find information quickly by using the index pages effectively.
- Building on previous Literacy lessons to improve our descriptive writing by adding new and varied detail.

PSHE/SEAL

Children will be looking into relationships and the importance of friendship. We will be thinking about how our own behaviour can affect others and reinforcing that the way we would like to be treated is also the way in which we should treat others.

We will also be looking at the differences between ourselves and celebrities. Putting ourselves into someone else's shoes to try and improve our empathy for others. This will again reinforce our schools rights and responsibilities, feeling proud of the achievements of others.

PE

In PE children will be taking part in group games with the coach to improve our teamwork with invasion skills and games.

The children will also be participating in Dance lessons, moving their bodies while keeping in time with the beat of music.

History

We will be looking into the history of the local area following the story of a King who lost his treasure somewhere in the fens.

RE

The children will be learning about Moses freeing the slaves from Egypt when looking at Judaism.

They will also be learning about Christian values of Stewardship and Dominion.

Maths

This term we will be developing our essential Maths skills to ensure we are able to answer questions using a range of supportive methods which will lead into a secure knowledge so that they can complete questions mentally.

Geography

The children will learn to name and locate different counties and cities in the UK. They will also identify human and physical characteristics of different areas.
