

Science- We will be learning about animals, including humans. The children will be finding out seven life processes and exploring the inner workings of the digestive system.

RE- The children will be learning about the story of Easter and the significance it has to Christians and the way they live their lives.

Geography- We will be investigating the different habitats around the world and the types of creatures that live in them. We will be looking at the physical traits of animals, life cycles, classification and exploring how they are suitable to various environments.

PE- This term the children will be improving on and learning swimming techniques. They will also be continuing to play team sports such as Hockey and Football with Coach.

Numeracy- This term we will be exploring decimals and fractions in greater detail. We will be focusing on problem solving and two step questions. The children will be practising their mental maths strategies and consolidating written methods for working out.

Music- The children will be looking at rhythm and tempo in music. They will have the chance to create a small drama/dance performance using appropriate percussion.

French- Throughout the term we will be continuing to expand our French skills. We will be learning about the topics of families, pets, weather and colours. We will also be practising our speaking and listening skills by asking and answering questions using common short phrases.

Literacy- We are looking at a variety of different genres this term including myths and legends. The children will have the opportunity to discover the world of magical beasts and beings. We will be discussing and debating various legends and creating one of our own. The class will complete a newspaper report on a chosen creature and have the chance to act out their favourite myth to the class.
