



The Romans

Science- We will be learning about light and sound. The children will explore the different types of light and find patterns in the way that the size of shadows changes. We will investigate how sound works and examine how vibrations travel over distance.

Music- The children will be looking at the different ways they can move their bodies to portray a certain feeling in dance. We will be listening to a variety of classical pieces and using them to help tell a story with our bodies.

Art and Design- This term we will be focusing on Roman Art and Roman Architecture. The children will learn how to create their own mosaic patterns using a variety of materials. They will also have the opportunity to design, plan and build a Roman Chariot.

History- The children will be investigating the history of the Roman Empire and its impact on Britain. We will be learning about the invasion of Julius Caesar, the Roman army, the way Romans lived and Roman technology.

PE- This term the children will be able to explore balance and agility in gymnastics. They will also be continuing to play team sports such as Hockey and Football with Coach.

Maths- This term we will be focusing on one and two step written problems. The children will be exploring how to choose the best method and apply it. We will be consolidating existing knowledge and expanding our number operations.

Literacy- This term we will continue to work with a wide variety of genres including plays and poetry. The children will have the opportunity to explore literacy through performance. We will also be looking at persuasive writing, adventure stories and non-chronological reports.

RE- The children will be investigating a number of different faiths and discovering how people's beliefs impact upon their everyday lives.

Geography- We will be investigating the different capitals and countries around the globe. The children will explore the different environmental regions, look at key physical features and learn about the different cultures in other countries.
