

Literacy

The children will be looking at a variety of different aspects in Literacy, they will be:

- Investigating the story of 'Toy Story' and writing their own version of a story where a toy comes to life.
 - Story mapping and retelling the story of 'George and the Dragon'.
 - Writing character descriptions of the Dragon and George, and setting descriptions of the town.
- We'll also be looking at a variety of different stories including The Magic Unicorn by Jenny Nimo, The Magic Faraway Tree and Winnie the Witch

Science

Children will be:

- Identifying, naming, drawing and labelling the basic parts of the human body and saying which part of the body is associated with each sense. As well as describing the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene
- Naming a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals, and name a variety of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores
- Observing changes of day and season

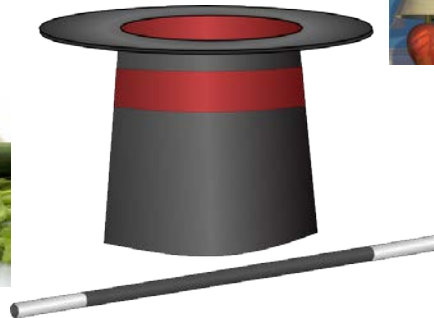
Art/DT

- Children will be using a variety of different techniques and materials to create self portraits.
- In DT children will be investigating, testing, designing, making and evaluating their own toys.

PSHE & SEAL

Children will be learning about developing relationships with other people, and how to respect the similarities and differences between people. Children will also be learning how to live a healthier lifestyle.

RE

Music

- Using body percussion
- Using their voices expressively and creatively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes.
- Investigating playground rhymes and songs

Geography and History

- We will also be comparing the similarities and differences between seasons, and discussing which is our favourite season and why.
