Road Safety

It has recently been brought to my attention that some of the children who attend our school are not behaving responsibly near the roads in Sutton St James and that some have had some very near misses with cars. In order to address this I have organised for Kay Taman (Lincolnshire County Road Safety Officer) to visit our school to educate all of the children about road safety. She will be in school on Thursday 8th October for the whole day. Mrs. Taman will work with all classes. Wrens and Swallows will be doing road safety activities and using resources in the classroom, whilst Owls and Herons children will be walked around Sutton St James in small groups, being shown how to cross the road safely including which places are safest to cross at and why. I hope that this will help to educate the children and make them think carefully about how dangerous roads can be and how they should behave when they are close to roads.
